- On June 11, 2015, the World Customs Organization (WCO) approved amendments to the tariff nomenclature of Chapters 3 (fish), 44 (wood and articles of wood), and 63 (certain made up textile articles) of the Harmonized System.

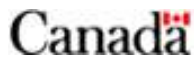

Dear Ambassador Froman:

We write to formally request the administration issue, as soon as possible, a proclamation designating duty-free benefits for travel goods for those Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) Beneficiary Developing Countries (BDCs) not already included in your June 30 proclamation granting duty-free benefits to Least Developed BDCs (LDBDCs) and African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA) countries. As supporters of the GSP program and its congressionally mandated purpose of spurring development through trade and investment while also enhancing the competitiveness of U.S. companies, we are very disappointed with the decision to defer a determination on travel goods eligibility for all GSP countries. Continued delay undermines benefits for U.S. consumers and companies and compromises the development of GSP eligible countries, many of which are allies of economic and strategic importance to the United States.

Congress drafted, introduced, and passed legislation expanding GSP eligibility for travel goods with the intent of providing duty-free access under GSP for all BDCs consistent with the criteria in the underlying GSP statute and past GSP eligibility practice. The decision to exclude key travel goods producers, including the Philippines, Indonesia, Thailand, India, Sri Lanka, and Pakistan, does not reflect Congressional intent or stakeholder input, and represents a missed opportunity to deliver a commercially meaningful expansion of products eligible for the GSP program which can spur needed development in BDCs.

Excluding these products undermines the broad trade and development policy rationale underling the GSP program. In 2015, China, which is not eligible for GSP benefits, supplied over three quarters of all travel goods imports. Total imports of products covered by this petition were just over 2 billion bags, and China supplied almost 1.8 billion of them, or 85%. Allowing benefits for all GSP countries gives them the opportunity to take this market share from China.

Nor would extending such benefits to all GSP countries harm the least developed. LDBDCs produce very few bags – in fact, all AGOA countries supplied just over 200,000 bags to the U.S. market as a group in 2015, or about 0.01% of the market. Therefore, the Administration's decision provides limited development benefits to the subset of GSP countries provided

eligibility because they cannot meet the demand or requirements of industry in the near future. Instead, the decision to expand GSP eligibility for travel goods only to countries that have extremely limited capacity to supply the travel goods market removes commercially significant incentives to diversify sourcing. Simply put, the policy rationale that the Administration has offered in support of its decision is not supported by commercial realities on the ground in GSP countries and non-GSP countries nor reflected in the development capacity of various GSP countries.

The International Trade Commission completed a thorough product eligibility review, and stakeholders were virtually unanimous in their support for extending preference to travel goods for all GSP countries. The indefinite delay of a decision for the remaining GSP countries creates unnecessary uncertainty and hurts U.S. consumers and retailers as well as the economies of the developing countries the GSP program is designed to help.

We therefore look forward to working with USTR to ensure preferential treatment for travel goods is promptly extended to all GSP beneficiaries.






